Event description:	The workshop on dangerous goods was held in Podgorica on 29th september, as part of the Science and Innovation Days. This event was organized and led by Montenegro Traffic Safety Observatory and Faculty of Mechanical Engineering.. The support organization of the meeting was provided by Ministry of Science and Technological Development and organization FiveG. On the first day of the program, the laboratories of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering were opened, where visitors had the opportunity to analyze the potential of modern technical solutions applied in the field of traffic, mechanical engineering and mechatronics. The most attractive equipment for visitors was the driving simulator, where participants could test their driving skills and knowledge in a virtual traffic environment. In addition, the devices for testing the quality of traffic signals were interesting, where visitors participated in a demonstration of the latest technologies used for the production of traffic signs and devices for their testing. On the second day of the program, activities were carried out under the name "Innovations in traffic safety education for future generations". Prof. Dr. Milanko Damjanović and Assoc. Dr. Boško Matović held a lecture on the factors young people are exposed to while participating in traffic. Through the presentation, the lecturers illustrated the facts regarding the representation of young people in the statistics of those killed and injured in traffic accidents on the roads in Montenegro. On the third day of the program, activities were carried out under the name "Innovations to better mobility in future smart cities". Prof Dr. Radoje Vujadinović gave a lecture on the traffic problems that people face every day while traveling to their desired destinations in cities - Illustrated are the facts regarding health, traffic, security and economic problems in cities in Montenegro. Participant of event were informed about objectives of the DGTRANS project and risks associated with the transport and storage of dangerous goods. Also, on this occasion the importance of applying and respecting international regulations in this area was highlighted.
