On June $3^{\rm rd}$ – $6^{\rm th}$, 2024, the LXVIII ETRAN Conference and $11^{\rm th}$ International Conference IcETRAN was held at the Faculty of Electronic Engineering at the University of Nis. During this conference the latest research results of over 700 scientists, researchers, experts and doctoral students from the country and abroad, referenced in 269 scientific papers and announcements are presented. They represent the latest achievements in the work of research teams and thus provide an opportunity to gain insight into the state of development of electrical engineering and computer science in Serbia, as well as in the region and even in the world.

This year's ETRAN and IcETRAN conferences indicate growing interest in scientific communication such as to exchange and discuss the latest scientific and research achievements, results and practical experiences in direct contact and to establish contacts for future cooperation and joint projects. The number of submitted and accepted works increased significantly this time (over 40%), which definitely reversed negative trend noticed in recent years.

Rector of the University of Pristina, temporarily seated in Kosovska Mitrovica held a welcome speech at the opening ceremony. Coordinator of DGTRANS project Doc. Dr Aleksandra Petrovic presented the project and explained the main goal of the project summing up the achievements the project gained so far.
